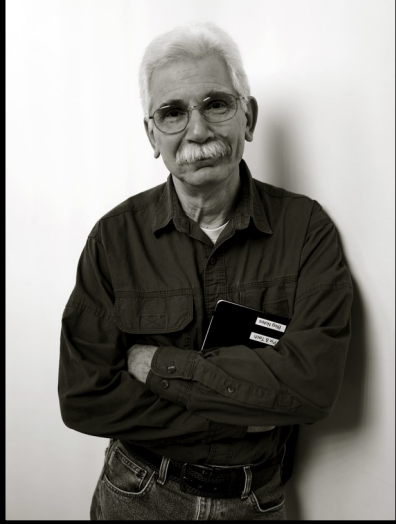

Printed Book, 1845-1890**
